#### • Food and Accommodation:

- 1. The CBSE Swimming Competition shall be conducted under the rules of the Swimming Federation of India (SFI), with modifications wherever applicable.
- 2. Every school will been titled to enter **only one swimmer** in each of the following events:

#### **IMPORTANT:**

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- \* UNDER-11Years Born on or after 01.01.2014
- \* UNDER-14 Years Born on or after 01.01.2011
- \* UNDER-17 Years Born on or after 01.01.2008
- \* UNDER-19 Years Born on or after 01.01.2006

Events marked (\*)will be conducted on time trial basis. It would mean that every swimmer in these events will get only one chance, and the final positions in these events will be determined on the basis of time recorded in different heats.

3. In under 11 years age group, a swimmer can participate in maximum three Individual events and in relays.

In under 14 years age group, a swimmer can participate in maximum four Individual events and in relays.

In under 17& 19 years age group, a swimmer can participate in **maximum five Individual events** and in relays.

- \* The Individual Championship (Best Swimmer) in any age group will be awarded only to **one** swimmer on the basis of medals won, and in case of tie, performance will be taken into consideration.
- 4. From each Zone, the first and second position winners will qualify to participate in the Nationals.
- 5. At Zone level, in case there are less than four swimmers present for a particular event, it may be conducted and swimmers may be awarded the medals and the merit certificate. But they may not be awarded the points so as to be included for the Individual or Team Championship. However, the names of first and second position winning swimmers may be forwarded for participation in Nationals.
- 6. At National level,in case there are less than four swimmers present for a particular event,it may be conducted and swimmers may be awarded the medals and the merit certificate. But they may not be awarded the points so as to be included for the Individual or Team Championship.

- 7. A separate prize may be given to the Individual Champion in Boys and Girls section,in all the age categories. For deciding the Individual Champion, the performance in the individual events and individual medley may be taken into consideration. In case of tie in points; two swimmers can be declared as joint Individual Champions.
- 8. A prize may be given to the school scoring total maximum points and may be declared as over-all Champion.
- 9. All the first three position winning swimmers shall be awarded with the Merit Certificate and the medal. However, only first and second position holders will participate in National event.
- 10. All the remaining participants shall be provided with a Participation Certificate.
- 11. In the case of relays, all the five members of the team(if five names are given before the meet in the eligibility Performa and all five have attended the meet) irrespective of who swims the finals, shall be awarded the Medals and Certificates.

- 12. New Meet Record(s) wherever created should be clearly indicated as 'NMR'.
- 13. The school Organizing Zone Level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Perform
- 14. The participating school are requested to pay an amount of Rs.2500/-(Twenty Five Hundred Only .CASH) as Caution deposit at the time of registration and the amount will be given back after getting the Clearance from the incharge.
- 15. Swimmers should report as soon as the first announcement is made.
- 16. Swimmers should wear proper Swimming costume.
- 17. The swimmers who placed first and second in EAST Zone must stay until the final day of the competition for the group photography.for the upcoming national competition
- 18. **Due to participant safety precautions**.if any of the participants have any skin-related medical conditions or viral fever. Before entering a competition, coaches must inform the organizer.
- 19. Only the manager or coach is permitted in the gallery when the swimmer is called to perform alongside the participant.
- 20. Following the participant, the participants and the concerned person must leave immediately.

### 21. Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following:

- 1. Principal, Organizing School
- 2. Organizing Secretary
- 3. CBSE Observer

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue.In case the protest is uphold the fee shall be refunded to the protesting school other wise the fee shall be forfeited.

• The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.

The decision,together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the **Joint Director** (Sports) CBSE.

#### THINGS SWIMMERS NEED TO BRING:

- \* SWIMMING COUSTME (GOOGLES,CAP AND TOWEL)
- \* FOR GIRLS:SWIMMING COUSTME
- \* FOR BOYS:TRUNKS OR JAMMER

#### FOOD AND ACCOMMODATION:

- Accommodation and arrangement for food will be made inside the Organizing School campus. An amount of Rs.500/- (Five hundred only) per head per day is to be paid towards the same and food coupons to be collected accordingly. Mode of Payment Cash only
- Tuck Shop will also be organized inside the campus on payable basis.
- The team member may please be instructed to observe discipline, code of conduct and use the school property with at most vigilance.
- Organizing School will not be responsible for any kind of loss of personal valuables including gold, ornaments, mobile phones, money etc

- If school property damaged by the participating team members, the damage cost will be incurred by them only.
- Smoking and drinking is strictly prohibited inside the school campus.
- On arrival at the organizing school the team needs to report to the Principal/Organizing Secretary
- It is mandatory for all the teams and officials to participate in the Opening Ceremony. They must bring the School flag for the ceremony.
- There will be a Meeting of Coach / Manager on 13<sup>th</sup> September,2024 at 7:30 PM in the School premises.
- Eatables from Outside will not be permitted inside the school dining hall.
- All meals will be served in school dining hall only.

- Food coupons are non-refundable, except when the entire team departs before the conclusion of the event.

- Maintain cleanliness in your dormitory.
- Engage in healthy and respectful activities.
- Keep corridors quiet during late hours.
